Course content consists of: 50% phrases and sentences, 25% vocabulary and 25% grammar.

- Public Speaking

This course focuses on improving conversational fluency. Course Content consists of: 50% conversation & literacy, 30% Grammar and 20% Vocabulary. This course is for individuals who communicate fluently in English, but with consistent grammatical errors.
